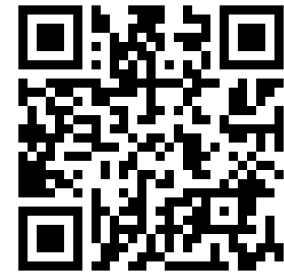

How to sign up for the event of your choice?
