OPENING CEREMONY

CERTIFICATES AND CLOSING CEREMONY

There are 120 hours of classes at the LŠSS and students who successfully pass them can receive 8 ECST credits.

You will receive your certificate from the 64th Sumer School of Slavonic Studies and a report with your final grades during the closing ceremony at the Profesní dům in Malá Strana (Malostranské nám. 2/25, Praha 1) on Thursday 19 August, starting at 15:00.

The farewell party and dinner take place on the evening of 19 August from 19:00 at the Kajetánka cafeteria.

USEFUL INFORMATION ABOUT THE LŠSS

UNIVERSITY CARD

All students will recieve their university card on the afternoon of Monday 26 July at UK Point, Celetná 13, Praha 1.

You will need your university card:

- to identify yourself and enter the FF UK building
- » to identify yourself and enter the Kajetánka dormitory
- » to connect to the internet at FF UK and the Kajetánka dormitory (the temporary password that you will get during registration is only valid until Monday 26 July)
- » to print and copy documents at FF UK
- » to use the library
- » to get a student discount from Czech cultural institutions

INTERNET ACCESS AT FF UK BUILDINGS

FF UK uses the EDUROAM wi-fi network. You will receive your temporary login credentials during registration. On the afternoon of Monday 26 July, you must pick up your university card. You can also sign in with the credentials from your university (www.eduroam.org).

LŠSS computers are available in room S131.

HEALTH

If you have any health problems, please contact Ivana Petrželová (LŠSS office in room 303) who will arrange a medical examination and interpreters for you.

To see a doctor, you will need:

- your health insurance card
- » money in cash (large hospitals also accept cards).

The fee that you will pay depends on the terms and conditions of your health insurance (country of origin, contracts with doctors, co-insurance limits etc.).

If you decide to see a doctor on your own and do not understand everything that's written in your medical report in Czech, please contact the LŠSS office, your teacher or an interpreter whom you trust. This will prevent any complications caused by incorrect treatment.

ACCOMMODATION — KAJETÁNKA DORMITORY

Internal students are staying at the Kajetánka dormitory.

Address: blok B, Radimova ulice č. 12, Praha 6 – Břevnov. The reception desk is open 24 hours a day; phone number +420 233 095 112.

At the reception desk, you will receive:

- » a chip card (to enter the dormitory);
- » a hotel card (to enter the cafeteria);
- » keys to your room.

Giving your cards to another person is expressly forbidden.

Please always carry the chip card with you.

INTERNET

Rooms at the Kajetánka dormitory are covered by wi-fi.

You can sign in through EDUROAM. You will receive a temporary password in your registration package after you arrive at the dormitory. This password will be valid only until Monday 26 July.

You will receive your university card on the afternoon of Monday 26 July at the UK Point in Celetná street in the centre of Prague.

If your university uses EDUROAM, you can also use your existing credentials instead.

GETTING FROM THE DORMITORY TO CITY CENTRE

The Faculty of Arts is right next to the tram and metro stop Staroměstská. It takes about 25 minutes to get there from the dormitory. To get there:

- » Take the bus no. 180 to Dejvická and transfer to metro line A (the bus stop is on the opposite side of the road from the dormitory; to get back, take the bus from the Kafkova stop)
- » Alternatively, you can take the tram 22 or 25 from the Drinopol stop (on Bělohorská street); get off on Malostranská and walk across the bridge

DORMITORY RULES

- » Please observe the hours from 22:00 to 6:00; during quiet hours, you can't play musical instruments, loud music, sing, shout or slam the doors.
- » Close and lock the door to your room to prevent theft.
- » Please make your room available for cleaning which takes place between 9:00 and 12:00.
- » Do not hang anything on the balcony nets or take them down.
- » Do not exceed the maximum weight capacity of lifts

VISITS OF YOUR FRIENDS AND FAMILY

All visitors to the dormitory need to sign the visitor book at the reception desk.

If you want to book a room for a family member or friend, please contact the dormitory's accommodation office. You can order meals for them in the cafeteria.

FACILITIES AT THE DORMITORY

- » The entrance hall contains a study room, copy machine and vending machines for coffee, tea, soft drinks and snacks; the reception desk sells sandwiches.
- » Kitchenette on each floor, fridge in every room unit.
- » Laundry room (pick up keys and pay at the reception desk)
 - > fee: CZK 30.00 / 1 washing cycle
 - > dryer: refundable deposit of CZK 50
 - > clothes iron: CZK 10.00 / 30 minutes
 - > ironing board: not available
 - > detergent: bring your own
- » The TV room and club room are on the mezzanine by the cafeteria.
- » There is a billiards room (you need to pay an entrance fee).

KAJETÁNKA DORMITORY CAFETERIA

The cafeteria (or "menza") is located on the first floor (take the stairs opposite the reception desk). The cafeteria serves breakfasts and dinners, and lunches during the weekend.

On Saturday 31 July and 14 August (day trip), you will get a package lunch at breakfast.

On Friday 20 August (departure day), you will only get breakfast and a package for your journey home.

On weekdays, you can find your own lunch anywhere in the city centre. Please pay attention to the designated meal hours and leave the cafeteria at the latest 20 minutes after the meal hours end.

CLASSES

The classes include:

Classes are taught at: Filozofická fakulta Univerzity Karlovy, nám. Jana Palacha 2, Praha 1 (metro A, station Staroměstská).

- Meet us at 9:00 at the aula FF UK (room no. 131)
- Your teachers will guide you to your classrooms

Classes end on the morning of Thursday 19 August. A small closing ceremony will be held on the afternoon of 19 August where you'll receive your certificates.

Morning courses are divided into groups by language level:

GROUP I

Language course for beginners based on English (German, French). 5×45 minutes every day, 9:00–13:15.

Includes mandatory phonetics lessons:

- 2nd week in the afternoons (2–6 August 2021)
- » individual lessons for 1–2 students
- one lesson takes 30 minutes (you will be excused from class)

In the afternoons, students can attend:

- » workshops in English or simple Czech (see WORKSHOPS)
- » optional phonetics lessons (see PHONETICS COURSES)

GROUP II

Language course for lower intermediate students based on English (German, French).

 5×45 minutes every day, 9:00–13:15.

In the afternoons, students can attend:

- » workshops in English or simple Czech (see WORKSHOPS)
- » optional phonetics lessons (see PHONETICS COURSES)

GROUP III

Intermediate language course.

5×45 minutes every day, 9:00–13:15:

- 9:00–11:35 language course
- » 11:45–13:15 conversation

In the afternoons, students can attend:

- » workshops in Czech (see WORKSHOPS)
- » optional phonetics lessons (see PHONETICS COURSES)
- » optionally also lectures in Czech intended for Group IV (see LECTURES)

GROUP IV

Advanced language course.

5×45 minutes every day:

- » 9:00–10:30 language course
- » 10:50–12:20 optional seminar (see below)

Monday, Wednesday, Friday:

» 12:30–14:00 mandatory lectures, see LECTURES

Optional seminars:

- » IV.1 Grammar and vocabulary exercises
- » IV.2 Introduction to legal Czech
- » IV.3 Czech life and culture
- » IV.4 Czech literature

PHONETICS COURSES

For the entire duration of the LŠSS, we offer phonetics courses taught by specialists from the FF UK's Institute of Phonetics, in rooms 12–18 on ground floor.

- 1. doc. PhDr. Jan Volín, Ph.D.: Introduction to the Czech Phonetics
- 2. PhDr. Jitka Veroňková, Ph.D.: Zvuková podoba současné češtiny

2nd week (2–6 August 2021) – mandatory phonetics course for Group I:

- » one lesson of 30 minutes.
- » 1 trainer + 2 students
- » in the morning session, i.e. 9:00–13:15 (you will leave your language course to go to phonetics class)
- » will be scheduled individually

2nd week (Tuesdays and Thursdays 14:30–14:45) – **phonetics workshop**:

- » for students of all groups
- » 45 minutes
- » training selected phonetic phenomena in groups
- » sign up in TripFon

3rd and 4th week (9–18 August 2021) – **phonetics consultations**:

- » for students of all groups
- » one lesson of 20 minutes
- » 1 trainer + 1 student
- » sign up in TripFon
