USEFUL INFORMATION ABOUT THE LŠSS

INTERNET ACCESS

- » FF UK and Kajetánka dormitory use the EDUROAM wi-fi network. You will receive your login credentials during registration.
- » You can also sign in with the credentials from your university (www.eduroam.org).
- » LŠSS computers are available in room S131.

HEALTH

If you have any health problems, please contact Ivana Petrželová / Ivana Skenderija (LŠSS office in room 303) who will arrange a medical examination and interpreters for you.

To see a doctor, you will need:

- » your health insurance card;
- » money in cash (large hospitals also accept cards).

The fee that you will pay depends on the terms and conditions of your health insurance (country of origin, contracts with doctors, co-insurance limits etc.).

If you decide to see a doctor on your own and do not understand everything that's written in your medical report in Czech, please contact the LŠSS office, your teacher or an interpreter whom you trust. This will prevent any complications caused by incorrect treatment.

ACCOMMODATION – KAJETÁNKA DORMITORY

Internal students are staying at the Kajetánka dormitory.

Address: blok B, Radimova ulice č. 12, Praha 6 – Břevnov.

The reception desk is open 24 hours a day; phone number +420 233 095 112.

At the reception desk, you will receive:

- » a chip card (to enter the dormitory);
- » a hotel card (to enter the cafeteria);
- » keys to your room.

Giving your cards to another person is expressly forbidden.

Please always carry the chip card with you.

GETTING FROM THE DORMITORY TO CITY CENTRE

About 25 minutes:

- » **bus no. 180** to Dejvická and transfer to metro line A to station Staroměstská (the bus stop is on the opposite side of the road from the dormitory; to get back, take the bus from the Kafkova stop)
- » **tram no. 22** from the Drinopol stop (on Bělohorská street); get off on Malostranská and walk across the Mánes bridge

DORMITORY RULES

- » Quiet hours are from 22:00 to 6:00; during quiet hours, you can't play musical instruments and loud music, sing, shout or slam the doors.
- » Close and lock the door to your room to prevent theft.
- » Please make your room available for cleaning which takes place between 9:00 and 12:00.
- » Do not exceed the maximum weight capacity of lifts.

VISITS OF YOUR FRIENDS AND FAMILY

All visitors to the dormitory need to sign the visitor book at the reception desk.

If you want to book a room for a family member or friend, please contact the dormitory's accommodation office. You can order meals for them in the cafeteria.

FACILITIES AT THE DORMITORY

- » The entrance hall contains a study room, copy machine and vending machines for coffee, tea, soft drinks and snacks; the reception desk sells sandwiches.
- » Kitchenette on each floor, fridge in every room unit.
- » Laundry room (pick up keys and pay at the reception desk)
 - › fee: CZK 30.00 / 1 washing cycle
 - › dryer: refundable deposit of CZK 50
 - › clothes iron: CZK 10.00 / 30 minutes
 - › ironing board: not available
 - › detergent: bring your own
- » The TV room and club room are on the mezzanine by the cafeteria.
- » There is a billiards room, table tennis and gym (you need to pay an entrance fee).

COMPLAINTS BOOK

There is a book for your complaints and comments at the reception desk. Please write down all your comments concerning your accommodation and cleaning services.

If anything is broken in your room, please report it in a book at the reception desk or contact our office.

You are not allowed to change rooms with someone else without prior approval of the LŠSS office!

MEALS

The cafeteria (or “menza”) Kajetánka serves breakfasts and dinners, and lunches during the weekend.

On Saturday 30 July and 13 August (day trip), you will get a package lunch at breakfast.

On Friday 19 August (departure day), you will only get breakfast and a package for your journey home. Please pay attention to the designated meal hours and leave the cafeteria at the latest 20 minutes after the meal hours end.

On weekdays, you can find your own lunch anywhere in the city centre; you will receive meal vouchers that you can use.

At the main building of the Faculty, you can try the Mezi řádky bistro. Here you can get a hot meal under CZK 100, sandwiches, salads, confectionery, coffee and tea.

CLASSES

The classes include:

GROUP II

Language course for lower intermediate students

5 × 45 minutes every day, 9:00–13:15.

GROUP III

Intermediate language course

5 × 45 minutes every day, 9:00–13:15:

PHONETICS COURSES

For the entire duration of the LŠSS, we offer phonetics courses taught by specialists from the FF UK's Institute of Phonetics, in rooms 12–18 on the ground floor.

TRIPFON

TripFon is our website app where you will sign up for workshops, individual phonetics consultations, Wednesday trips, weekend trips and the afternoon and evening programme.

You can open it by going to tripfon.ff.cuni.cz or scanning a **QR code** (see below).

TripFon also includes a calendar with all the events that you signed up for. The calendar also shows events planned for all students as well as those that are mandatory for certain courses (e.g. lectures for the IV courses).

How to sign up for the event of your choice?

- » Sign in – your username is your e-mail address, the password is LSSS.FF2022 (please change this to a more secure password of your choice)
- » Select from the offer in the individual folders:
 - › *Learning* – here you pick **Workshops**
 - › *Corrective pronunciation* – here you choose **Individual phonetics consultations**
 - › *Trips* – this section is for **Weekend trips**
 - › *Culture* – here you choose from the **Afternoon and evening programme**
- » Sign up by clicking on REGISTER ME.
