The National Memorial on the Vítkov Hill

The National Memorial on Vítkov was originally built as a tribute to Czechoslovak legionnaires (army abroad), but now it is managed by the Czech Army together with the National Museum, which has set up a permanent exhibition dedicated to the changes of Czech statehood in 20th century. We will see the originally planned function of the mausoleum in the underground space called Laboratory of Power. From the highest point of the building, there is a really impressive view of lesser-known parts of Prague, which is a reward for all those who managed to climb Vítkov Hill in the hot summer.
